



Dr. Mihály Kádár, 63, graduated as medical doctor in 1973 and had post graduation in medical laboratory and public health sciences. He has worked since 1974 for the National Institute of Environmental (formerly: Public) Health, first as microbiologist at the dept. of Water Hygiene, then as the head of the laboratory and from 2000 to 2011 as the head of the department. He represented Hungary in committees with the EU Commission for the directives on drinking water and bathing water, and took part in the international standardisation on water microbiology. He lead several research activities including work packages in EU FW Projects like EPIBATHE (2006-9). He pursued activities for the Protocol on Water and Health as national focal point, chairman of the Working Group on Water and Health and member of the Bureau. He organised the first International Conference on Pool and Spa Hygiene in 2005 in Budapest.

He retired in 2011 and works for the Institute as part time counsellor.
